KINDS OF EXAM

 - Procedure Text** (*how to make something / how to do something*)
 - Descriptive Text** (*describe thing, people, place*)
 - Narrative Text** (*imaginative story to entertain people*)
 - Anecdote Text** (*a short amusing/interesting story about a real incident or person*)
